A NEW ERA OF CALIFORNIA POLICY FOR ENGLISH LEARNERS - A CLOSER LOOK AT WHAT PROP 58 AND THE NEW EL ROADMAP MEAN FOR YOU

The CABE 2018 Administrator Leadership Symposium will provide school board members and district and site leaders with a keen inside look at the new English Learner Roadmap Policy approved by the State Board of Education in 2017. The EL Roadmap Policy is intended to assist districts, schools and county offices of education in welcoming, understanding, and educating the diverse population of students who are English Learners attending California public schools.

This year's symposium will feature a presentation by Dr. Laurie Olsen, co-lead of the EL Roadmap Workgroup and several members of the workgroup that met for over a year to design and develop the English Learner Roadmap Policy. Participants will be engaged in reviewing and planning for the implementation of the shifts and changes that the EL Roadmap Policy provides and exploring the direct impact it will have in their own schools and districts. Each participant will receive a copy of the English Learner Roadmap Policy.
